Before you start, take a long, hard look at what you will keep in your garage - and how functional you want it to be. By planning ahead, you'll make the right decisions and be truly satisfied with the results. Here are a few things to consider:



- Get organized! Sort through all the items you want to store - from lawn equipment to snow shovels and kids' toys - and determine how much space you need for them.
- Decide whether or not you want to include shelving, cabinets, work benches, pegboards for tools, or hanging brackets for things like bikes.
- Consider the placement of windows to allow for maximum natural light.
- Think about options like electrical outlets (how many and where they should be placed), and whether or not you need to add a comfortable heating & ventilation system.
- Plan your driveway so there is a minimum 10' radius for turns and a minimum width of 10' for one car and 16' for two cars.
- Check your local zoning restrictions.

The Basic Package

- 2x4 treated bottom plate
- 2x4 stud walls @ 16" O/C
- Siding either 5/8" T1-11 w/#2 pine trim or vinyl w/7/16" OSB
- 25-year fiberglass shingles over 7/16" OSB and 15# felt
- Ridge vent
- Aluminum drip edge (gable and eave)
- Aluminum soffit
- 1' eave overhang
- 8000 series (non-insulated) overhead garage door

The Standard Package

- 2x4 treated bottom plate
- 2x4 stud walls @ 16" O/C
- Siding either 5/8" T1-11 w/#2 pine trim or vinyl w/7/16" OSB
- *1/2" OSB roof sheathing*
- 25-year fiberglass shingles over 1/2" OSB and 15# felt
- Ridge vent
- Aluminum drip edge (gable and eave)
- Aluminum soffit
- *Flush steel 3/0 man door*
- 1' eave overhang
- *9100 series (insulated) overhead garage door*
